## ALZHEIMER FORSCHUNG INITIATIVE e.V. (AFI)

## PUBLICATION GRANTS – GRANTS FOR OPEN ACCESS PUBLICATIONS GUIDELINES & INSTRUCTIONS

AFI covers publication costs in open access journals for young scientists. Free access to the latest research results is a major concern for AFI. Publications on the topic of Alzheimer's disease or Alzheimer's disease related dementias are supported with a grant of up to € 1,000. As a fundraising organisation, AFI aims to facilitate open access publications and expects that other funding opportunities have been exhausted prior to application. Any difference can be requested from AFI.

## What are the conditions to be granted a subsidy?

- The article has significant relevance to research on Alzheimer's disease or other rare dementias.
- The selected journal publishes all articles immediately after publication Open Access (True Open Access journal). Open Access options for individual articles in journals requiring subscription cannot be funded.
- The applicant is a first author or corresponding author and employed at a university or other public institution in Germany.
- The applicant is a PhD student or post-doc.
- The journal fulfils the scientific quality criteria applicable to the respective subject and is peer-reviewed. As a rule, comments are not funded.
- Authors who publish results from externally funded projects undertake to check whether the
  publication costs can be covered by third-party funds earmarked for this purpose (e.g. DFG
  publication cost flat rate or support from the university library) and to exhaust these, if
  available.
- Please include a sentence (acknowledgement) in the publication in which you mention the funding from the AFI: "We acknowledge support from Alzheimer Forschung Initiative e.V. for Open Access Publishing".

## How to apply?

The following documents are to be submitted:

- A short application letter on the university's / institution's paper incl. a short written confirmation that other funding sources have already been exhausted
- Preliminary article
- Layman's summary of the article in German (300-400 words)
- Proof of publication costs
- A list of other sponsors if present, including the respective sums
- PhD students submit an endorsement from their supervisor

You will receive a response no later than 2 weeks after submitting your application. After publication, please send us the final article with the DOI.
